	SUCH AS: OF ALL WOMEN WHO GET MAMMOGRAMS, 10 PERCENT WILL GET CALLED BACK FOR ADDITIONAL VIEWS. OF ALL WOMEN WHO HAVE BIOPSIES TO EXAMINE A SPOT THAT SHOWED UP ON A MAMMOGRAM, 80-PERCENT WILL NOT HAVE CANCER. DR. PRUTHI SAYS THE KEY MESSAGE FOR WOMEN LIKE ANNETTE IS THAT JUST BECAUSE YOU HAVE TO HAVE A BIOPSY OR ADDITIONAL IMAGES TAKEN, IT DOES NOT MEAN YOU HAVE BREAST CANCER.
